Sea-to-Sky Highway Improvement Project

The Sea-to-Sky Highway Improvement Project invites local residents and businesses to attend an open house to provide feedback on detailed design features associated with improvements to the Brandywine to Function Junction (Whistler) section of the Sea-to-Sky Highway.

The Sea-to-Sky Highway Improvement Project upgrades cover the area between Horseshoe Bay and Whistler.

When the project is completed in 2009, travel along the highway will be safer and more reliable for residents, commuters and tourists.

The consultation includes gathering feedback on detailed design features such as community gateway signage and landscaping.
