### **Lions Bay Open House February 28, 2004**

The Ministry of Transportation invites the Lions Bay Community Advisory Group, residents and the public to provide input and feedback on draft pre-design options for Sea-to-Sky Highway Improvement Project.

#### **Draft Pre-Design Options**

Improvements for the 3.5 km section of the Sea-to-Sky Highway from the southern Village limit at Kelvin Grove to M Creek Bridge beyond the northern Village limit are designed to improve safety, reliability and capacity, consistent with the goals for the overall project.

#### **Highway Improvement Design Options**

Improvements to the section of the Sea-to-Sky Highway in Lions Bay are designed to improve safety, reliability and capacity, consistent with the goals for the overall project and in consideration of community objectives, issues and concerns. Options have been developed for input and feedback from the community. Options address project goals and community concerns to varying degrees. Each option will be visually presented to residents and stakeholders including summary information about such things as access, costs, benefits and how each option addresses project goals and community concerns.

#### **Design Options**

##### **Option 1 - Four lane**

*Highway upgrade to 4 lanes incorporating Village treatment*

##### **Option 2 – Two-lane**

*Upgrade to two lanes incorporating Village treatment.*

## **Lions Bay Consultation Goals**

The goals of the Preliminary Design Consultation with the Village of Lions Bay are to:

- a. **Inform the community and stakeholders about the pre-design options** for improvements to the Sea-to-Sky Highway within Lions Bay.
- b. **Gather input and feedback** regarding the pre-design options for highway improvements from the community and stakeholders.
- c. **Summarize community and stakeholder input** for consideration by the Ministry of Transportation. Distribute the *Consultation Summary Report* to consultation participants, Lions Bay Community Advisory Group (CAG), the Village of Lions Bay and other stakeholders.

## **Community and Stakeholder Input**

Community and Stakeholder input will be recorded and summarized into a *Consultation Summary Report* for consideration by the Ministry of Transportation and for distribution to consultation participants including the Village of Lions Bay, CAG and other stakeholders.
