Opportunity for Community Feedback on Preliminary Design Features for Improvements to the West Vancouver Section of the Sea-to-Sky Highway

The Sea-to-Sky Highway Improvement Project invites local residents and stakeholders to provide feedback on preliminary design features for improvements to the West Vancouver section of the Sea-to-Sky Highway.

Improvements are being undertaken to the highway between Nelson Creek and Pasco Road to improve safety, reliability and capacity. By 2009, extensive highway improvements will make travel along the highway safer and more reliable for residents, commuters and tourists.

The consultation with the community of West Vancouver includes gathering community feedback regarding refinements to the Eagleridge Interchange, North Junction (new Highway 99 and the old highway), gateway signage for West Vancouver and the Sea-to-Sky Highway Corridor, landscaping, location of bus stops and landscape options for cuts and fills.
