RFP-7.1	Volume 1	Section 2.5.4	<p>2.5.4 Land Acquisition Procedure for Section DB4 [As revised in Addendum RFP-3.1, Issued November 4, 2004]</p> <p>The preliminary design and associated mapping has not been completed to a level that property requirements can be defined within the limits of Section DB4 (Brunswick Beach to Porteau Cove). As part of their Proposals, Proponents will submit a design for what they propose to build in Section DB4 and associated right-of-way requirements. The current right-of-way is shown in Volume 3, Appendix 3B, drawings 41DD-DB04-0201 Rev. 0 through 41DD-DB04-0214 Rev. 0 included in Appendix 3B of Volume 3, within the lines described as "existing right-of-way".</p> <p>Following entering into the DBFO Agreement, DBFO Co must submit right-of-way acquisition drawings, including cross sections and elevations, not less than 12 months before DBFO Co requires access to the right-of-way to facilitate construction. The Province will acquire, at DBFO Co's cost, the lands identified in DBFO Co's Proposed Right-of-Way that lie outside the existing right-of-way lines on drawings 41DD-DB04-0201 Rev. 0 through 41DD-DB04-0214 Rev. 0, in accordance with DBFO Co's proposed property acquisition schedule included in its New Construction Work Schedule.</p>	<p>2.5.4 Land Acquisition Procedure for Section DB4</p> <p>The preliminary design and associated mapping has not been completed to a level that property requirements can be defined within the limits of Section DB4 (Brunswick Beach to Porteau Cove). The Province will acquire, at DBFO Co's the Province's cost, the lands identified in DBFO Co's Proposed Right-of-Way that lie outside the existing right-of-way lines on drawings 41DD-DB04-0201 Rev. 0 through 41DD-DB04-0214 Rev. 0, in accordance with DBFO Co's proposed property acquisition schedule included in its New Construction Work Schedule except for lands (other than Acquisition Lands) within the BC Rail Right of Way or lands which are otherwise owned or within the control of BC Rail or CN Rail. Acquisition of any lands (other than Acquisition Lands) within the BC Rail Right of Way or lands which are otherwise owned or within the control of BC Rail or CN Rail will be at the cost and risk of DBFO Co.</p>
