CONSTRUCTION BULLETIN

November 24, 2006

Night blasting from Pasco Road north to Ansell Place

Construction crews continue road widening from the Pasco Road area, approximately 3 km north of Horseshoe Bay north to Ansell Place. This work requires blasting, which is scheduled between December 3 to December 15, 2006 and from January 2 to January 31, 2007. Hours of work are 10 pm to 6 am, Sunday to Thursday, and will require traffic delays of up to 15 minutes.

Improvements to this highway segment have been re-designed to reduce the amount of required blasting. Noise associated with this type of work is unavoidable and crews will make every effort to minimize disruptions to neighbouring areas, including the use of blast mats.
