### *Sea-to-Sky Highway Improvement Project*

---

#### **Preliminary clearing work to begin just south of Pasco Road**

Starting March 1, the Sea-to-Sky Highway Improvement Project will begin clearing work on an approximately 1.5 km section of the west side of Highway 99 just south of Pasco Road. This work will occur on Crown land and involve preparation of an access road, tree removal and then geotechnical work in preparation for the design and construction of the new Pasco Road access.

This work will have minimal impact on traffic on the existing highway and will take place during the day for approximately six to eight weeks. Work on the new Pasco Road access will begin May 1, 2006 and will be part of the \$600 million in safety, reliability and capacity improvements planned for the Sea-to-Sky Highway.
