### *Sea-to-Sky Highway Improvement Project*

#### **Closure of Passing Lane North of Lions Bay**

A detour will be implemented effective February 23 (weather permitting) from Brunswick Beach Road to 600 metres north of Harvey Creek. The detour will result in the closure of the southbound passing lane, immediately north of Lions Bay, for the duration of the construction period. In addition, the speed limit through this area will be reduced to 60 kph.

Safe passing opportunities are now available directly south of Lions Bay with the recent opening of the new 4 lane, 6.5 kilometre section of highway.

This shifting of lanes is being done to provide safe access to and from the Brunswick Pit area for trucks and equipment working in areas north of Lions Bay and is **not** the start of construction in Lions Bay. Lions Bay construction will begin after Preliminary Design Consultation has been completed later this year.
