### *Sea-to-Sky Highway Improvement Project*

#### **Work Begins Between Murrin Park and Shannon Falls Park**

In early March, the Sea-to-Sky Highway Improvement Project will begin clearing work on both sides of the highway starting approximately 500 metres south of Shannon Creek, and continuing to approximately 400 metres north Murrin Provincial Park, in preparation for excavation work to begin.

When it begins, this excavation work will involve drilling and blasting for upslope cuts and downslope fills. Clearing and grubbing will be ongoing throughout the drilling and blasting phase. Work will continue on day and night shifts, with periodic traffic closures and delays required to ensure it is completed safely. There will be no disruption to traffic on weekends.

There will be no impacts on access to Shannon Falls or Murrin Provincial Parks.

This is the beginning of work that will result in improvements that include twinning of the Gonzales Creek Bridge and widening to four lanes with a concrete median barrier. The target date for completion is Fall 2006.
