



# ***Sea-to-Sky Highway Improvement Project***

## **Construction Bulletin**

**June 9, 2006**

### **Construction Work Begins South of Shannon Falls Intersection**

Construction work will begin on or about June 21, 2006 on the Sea-to-Sky Highway in the area immediately south of the Shannon Falls intersection and will continue south to Murrin Provincial Park. The construction work will include clearing, grubbing, drilling, blasting and roadworks.

In preparation for work to begin, the north and southbound lanes will be shifted while maintaining existing traffic flow. Speed limits during the construction will be 50 kilometres per hour during daytime construction work. Construction will take place between 7:00 am to 5:00 pm unless otherwise identified. Access to local parks, businesses and residents will be maintained during the construction period.

Initial work will occur on the mountainous (east) side of the highway with clearing, grubbing and rock excavation followed by roadworks. This stage of construction work is expected to take four to five months.

Sea-to-Sky Highway improvements through Shannon Falls Provincial Park will include widening the existing highway to a four-lane divided highway with a separate left-hand turn lane. Improvements also include widening existing four-way signalized intersection to accommodate four lanes of traffic. A centre median barrier will be constructed as a safety feature through the four-lane section and a new northbound bridge will be built adjacent to the existing Shannon Creek bridge.
