Geotechnical Studies Begin in the Pinecrest / Black Tusk Area

To prepare for highway design prior to construction later this year in the Pinecrest/Black Tusk area, geotechnical and environmental teams are in the area north of the Daisy Lake dam to north of Black Tusk (Widow Creek).

Geotechnical crews will be working in this area on or about June 14, 2006. This work, which is expected to take approximately one week, involves excavating 20 test sites to sample rock and soil in the area to assist in the development of the highway design. Some tree falling will be required. The work is off-highway and therefore will have no impact on traffic movement. No noise impacts are expected as a result of this work.

The environmental team is conducting bird surveys and other environmental investigations.
