### **Culvert installations through the Squamish area**

Construction crews will begin installing new culverts as part of the Sea-to-Sky Highway Improvement Project in the Squamish area from Mamquam River to Depot Road beginning on or about August 20.

Some night shift work, scheduled from 8 pm to 6 am daily will be required for culvert installation at Hop Creek Ranch (1.6km north of Garibaldi Way) and Dryden Creek (200m south of Depot Road). Use of single-lane-alternating traffic patterns on Highway 99 in these two areas will be required with maximum 10 minute stoppages. Work on these new culverts should be completed by September 15.

The balance of the culvert replacement work will be carried out during normal day shift hours of 6 am 7 pm and traffic delays will be minimal.
