Construction Hours Extended for Special Equipment

Specialized drilling equipment has become available to crews for a very limited time. The equipment must be used to its full availability to prepare for construction of the new Eagleridge eastbound on-ramp to Highway 1. The drilling will take place beneath the Eagleridge Drive overpass, adjacent to the eastbound lanes of the highway.

Specialized drilling work will be intermittently scheduled:

**September 18 to October 6
7 am to 10 pm**

Regular work hours are 7 am to 5 pm. Please note that, because this is not the percussion-type drilling normally used for rock-blasting work, noise levels will be moderate in neighbouring areas.
