### **New Britannia Creek bridge construction set to begin**

Crews will begin construction of a new two-lane bridge across Britannia Creek following a week of geotechnical work from 7 am to 5 pm daily, which starts on or about October 10. Meanwhile, construction on the highway will move north, adjacent to the town centre.

Access to businesses in Britannia Beach will be maintained at all times.

Other Sea-to-Sky Highway improvements continue through Britannia Beach, including:

- Widening of the existing highway to primarily three lanes.
- Traffic and pedestrian safety improvements, including consolidation of existing accesses via a new signalized intersection at Main Street with raised median and traffic islands,
- A new concrete box culvert at Thistle Creek to provide improved fish spawning opportunities.
- Silt control and drainage improvements at Daisy Creek.
