Culvert installation at Mashiter spawning channels

Construction crews continue with culvert installation that began in August, as part of the Sea-to-Sky Highway Improvement Project in the Squamish area from Mamquam River to Depot Road.

Work is expected to begin on or about October 13 to install a concrete box culvert that will connect the Mashiter spawning channels on the east and west sides of the highway. This work is located just north of the Mamquam River.

This culvert installation will require lane shifting, but is not expected to have any impact on travelling public. Work will be completed during regular day shifts from 7 am to 5 pm in addition to night work from 5 pm to 7am. This work will take approximately two weeks to complete.
