Crushing operations resume in November at Brunswick Pit

Construction crews will resume aggregate crushing operations at Brunswick Pit on or about November 20, 2006 as they begin producing aggregate back fill for mechanically stabilized earth (MSE) walls. Brunswick Pit is located within the Village of Lions Bay, approximately 100 metres north of the Brunswick Beach intersection.

This cycle of crushing will take approximately one month. Work is scheduled from 7 am to 5 pm, Monday through Saturday. No night shifts are currently planned, but may be added if required.

Noise associated with this type of work is unavoidable however crews will make every effort to minimize disruptions to neighbouring areas. This work will have minimal impacts on highway traffic movement.
