November 16, 2006

Geotechnical work from Kelvin Grove to M Creek

Construction crews will perform geotechnical investigations from the Kelvin Grove area, located on the southern boundary of Lions Bay to M Creek, 3.5 km north beginning on or about November 20.

This work is expected to take about four weeks and is required to verify geotechnical conditions and advance highway improvement concepts reviewed in recent preliminary design consultation. The work will be conducted during normal day shift from 7 am to 5 pm. There will be little or no disruption to highway traffic and minimal noise when crews measure the depth of rock beneath the alignment.
