Night Blasting North of Britannia Creek Bridge

Construction on the Sea-to-Sky Highway in the Britannia Beach area requires that crews drill, blast and excavate rock to widen a portion of the highway immediately north of the Britannia Beach Bridge.

- **This work is currently scheduled to take place mid to late next week (week of April 30) and will take several days to complete.**
- **Night blasting will occur between the hours of midnight and 2 am during the regularly scheduled highway closure.**
- **This work is weather dependent and will proceed based on the availability of crews and equipment.**

A special notice board advising the community of the blasting schedule will be located in a prominent location adjacent to the Britannia Beach business area.

Noise associated with this type of work is unavoidable, and crews will make every attempt to minimize disruptions to neighbouring areas, including the use of blast mats.
