Work to begin on Pinecrest / Black Tusk by-pass

Construction crews are preparing to begin work at the site of the new Pinecrest / Black Tusk bypass. The work area is located about 300 metres north of Daisy Lake bridge to about 300 metres north of Widow Creek, and is expected to begin as early as the week of May 14.

Following preparatory work, construction will include tree clearing, excavation, and installation of some drainage and wildlife crossings.

The work is off-highway and therefore will have minimal impact on traffic. Highway traffic will be stopped only intermittently to allow trucks access to and from the work site. If you have any questions regarding construction-related noise please call 604-629-8283

The Pinecrest bypass will make the highway safer for local residents and through travellers by reducing the number of intersections.
