

## CONSTRUCTION BULLETIN

June 4, 2007

### Preliminary work scheduled for Kelvin Grove

Tree clearing will begin in the week of June 11 alongside the highway at Kelvin Grove, as the initial work toward a new mini-change. The Kelvin Grove mini-change will be a small interchange with full traffic movement to improve community connections and provide safe access for pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles to, and across the highway.

Kelvin Grove-area work is expected to proceed as follows toward completion in 2009 (*schedule subject to change, based on field conditions and design requirements*):

#### June to early fall 2007

- tree and brush clearing within the known footprint of the Kelvin Grove mini-change, highway ramps and northbound traffic calming area, followed by excavation and temporary access road construction as part of the geotechnical investigation (duration 3 to 4 months)
- limited blasting is expected as part of the geotechnical investigation. Pre-blast surveys will be performed on homes as required

#### Early fall to early winter 2007

- geotechnical investigation continues and wall designs completed
- utility relocations
- excavation and blasting for split grade portion of highway. Pre-blast surveys will be performed on homes as required

#### Winter 2007 to summer 2009

- highway wall and ramp construction
- split grade wall construction
- Kelvin Grove mini-change construction
- paving, line painting and traffic staging

Work will be done between 7 am and midnight Monday – Saturday, with minimal disruption to traffic.

Highway improvements through Lions Bay will include traffic-calming curves where traffic enters the community and enhanced medians as safety and speed control measures.
