Access to Pinecrest / Black Tusk community changes as realignment opens

Highway traffic is being moved on to the new alignment at Pinecrest /Black Tusk.

- When this traffic shift occurs, access to the Pinecrest / Black Tusk communities for northbound drivers will be accomplished through a left turn onto the “old highway” at the north end of the realignment.
- Southbound access to the Pinecrest / Black Tusk communities will be via a right turn at the same location.

When this traffic shift occurs, the existing south and northbound access to the “old highway” will be closed. Vehicles leaving Pinecrest and Black Tusk will need to use the new access described in this bulletin at the north end of the realignment to connect to the Sea-to-Sky Highway.

The new alignment will remain a speed-reduced zone.

In the spring motorists can expect further construction on the Pinecrest / Black Tusk realignment as the third lane, the final layer or “top lift” of pavement and highly reflective pavement markers are installed.
