April 20, 2009

North and southbound closures on 'old highway' between Pasco Road and Marine Drive

The 'old highway', from Pasco Road to Horseshoe Bay (newly named Horseshoe Bay Drive) will be closed in both directions beginning tomorrow **Tuesday April 21**, at 7:00am. The closures will be required for two days (weather dependent). This work requires both daytime and night closures.

These closures are required so that crews may remove safety barriers, mill and then lay the final layer of pavement.

Traffic control personnel will be located at both north and south ends of the work zone to direct traffic. North and southbound traffic will need to use the new Sea-to-Sky route to Eagleridge Interchange, or the turn-around at Caulfield Drive.

During the daytime closures, buses and emergency vehicles will be allowed through. Crews working during the night closures must remove the safety barriers, and there will be single-lane alternating traffic allowed through.

Every attempt will be made to minimize and reduce noise during this work. If you have any questions on noise or construction activity, please call the site office at 604-629-8283.
