CONSTRUCTION BULLETIN

April 23, 2009

Exit 2 closure at Eagleridge Drive for completion of Eagleridge roundabout

Crews will be completing work on the new Eagleridge Drive roundabout. The work includes concrete curbing, grading and paving. In order to accomplish this construction, Exit 2 (Eagleridge Drive) will be closed on or about April 27th. (Weather dependent) Work is scheduled to begin at 7am and continue for approximately 36 hours, concluding at 6pm the next day.

- Eagleridge Drive residents heading westbound on Highway 1 can access Eagleridge Drive via Horseshoe Bay Village. Residents will use Exit 3 to BC Ferries and Horseshoe Bay Village and can return to Eagleridge Drive via Nelson Avenue and Marine Drive.
- Eagleridge Drive residents heading eastbound on Highway 1 (southbound old Highway 99) will be able to exit to Eagleridge Drive, as construction works will be taking place on the east side of the existing Eagleridge structure.
- Residents who are exiting Eagleridge Drive to go northbound on Highway 99 or westbound on Highway 1 will need to use Exit 4 (Caulfeild Drive) to turn around. The existing Eagleridge overpass will be closed to facilitate construction on the east side of the overpass.

Every attempt will be made to minimize and reduce noise during this work. If you have any questions on noise or construction activity, please call the site office at 604-629-8283.
