May 14, 2009

Temporary closures of exits at Eagleridge and old highway at Pasco Road for final paving

Crews will begin working at locations on the old highway (Horseshoe Bay Drive) at Pasco Road followed by work at the Eagleridge Interchange area to complete final paving at these sites. This work involves milling and placement of the final layer of pavement. Work will take place beginning at the Pasco Road location and when complete, will move to the Eagleridge area. These closures are temporary and should last no more than one night. Electronic message boards will be in place to advise drivers of new directions.

STAGE ONE: Old highway/Pasco Road location

- Work will begin the week of May 19 following the Victoria Day long weekend. Hours of the night work are from 6pm – 6am. Southbound traffic to this roadway (the old highway/ Horseshoe Bay Drive) will be closed, but access for northbound traffic to the Sea-to-Sky highway will be maintained.
- Southbound traffic to Horseshoe Bay Drive and Pasco Road will be directed to the Caulfeild Drive turn-around at Exit 4 and then to Exit 2.
- ***During this work, Exit 2 will be closed for a period of approximately two hours between 8pm and 6am.*** During this time, traffic will be routed to Exit 3 to reach Marine Drive/ Eagleridge Drive via Keith Road in Horseshoe Bay Village.

STAGE TWO: Eagleridge Interchange location

- Work will take place the week of May 19th, following the Victoria Day long weekend. Hours of the night work are between 10pm – 3am. ***At 10pm, following the last ferry, Exit 3 (ferry lanes) will be closed. Traffic will be routed to Exit 2 to reach Horseshoe Bay Village.***
- Between 3am - 6am, lanes leading from the BC Ferry Terminal will be paved and tied into the Sea-to-Sky Highway. One lane will remain open at all times.

Every attempt will be made to minimize and reduce noise during this work. If you have any questions on noise or construction activity, please call the site office at 604-629-8283.
